Task Title: Breaking Jobs Down into Tasks

Answer Key

These are just suggestions. Make sure the learner has covered a logical set of steps and not missed any major tasks.

Task 1:

- 1 Measure your room and calculate how much paint you will need
- 2 Choose a paint colour
- 3 Buy the paint and supplies (buy filler, masking tape, paint brushes, rollers and a roller tray)
- 4 Take down pictures
- 5 May need to patch walls (apply filler, sand patches)
- 6 Move and/or cover furniture
- 7 Tape windows, trims, etc.
- 8 Paint first coat
- 9 Let first coat dry
- 10 If second coat needed paint again and let dry
- 11 Remove tape
- 12 Hang pictures
- 13 Put furniture back or uncover it
