

Scan "Erasing Images" on page 20 of the Canon Camera user's manual.


Erasing Images

You can select and erase images one at a time. Please note that erased images cannot be recovered. Exercise adequate caution before erasing an image.




1 Select the playback mode.

- Press the  button.
- ▶ The last image you took will appear.





2 Select an image to erase.

- Press the  buttons to select an image.



3 Erase the image.

- Press the  button.
- ▶ [Erase?] appears.
- Press the  buttons to select [Erase], then press the  button.
- ▶ The displayed image will be erased.
- To exit instead of erasing, press the  buttons to select [Cancel], then press the  button.
