Answer: Any three of

- equipment made of hard plastic (e.g. hard braces) is not permitted (unless approved by the Recreation Sport Programs Coordinator)
- watches are not permitted
- hats are not permitted for indoor sports
- brimmed hats are not permitted for outdoor sports
- metal cleats are not permitted
- gloves (hands) with adhesive substances applied to them (e.g. Stickum, Glove juice, etc.)
