- gasoline theft
- when cash count is short (if someone else had access to the cash till)
- faulty workmanship
- poor work that costs the company

Answer: The employee should not chase the customer/thief.

Task 3: What is the rule about deducting wages for bad workmanship?

Answer: Even when companies have to reimburse customers for a job poorly done, they cannot deduct the loss from their employees' wages, even if the employee agrees to pay for it.
