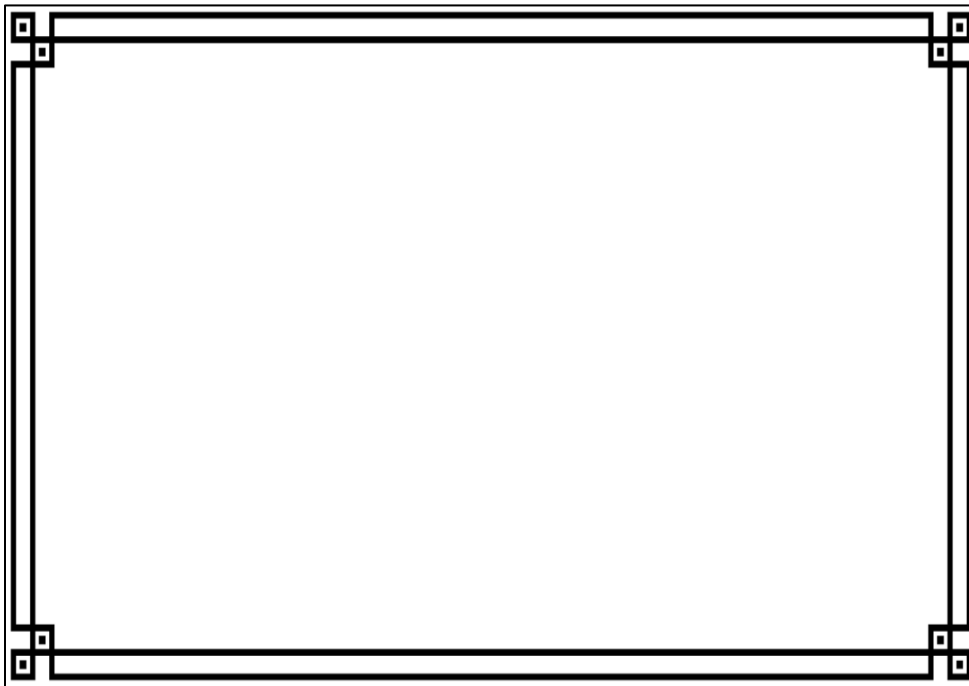

Outside of Card



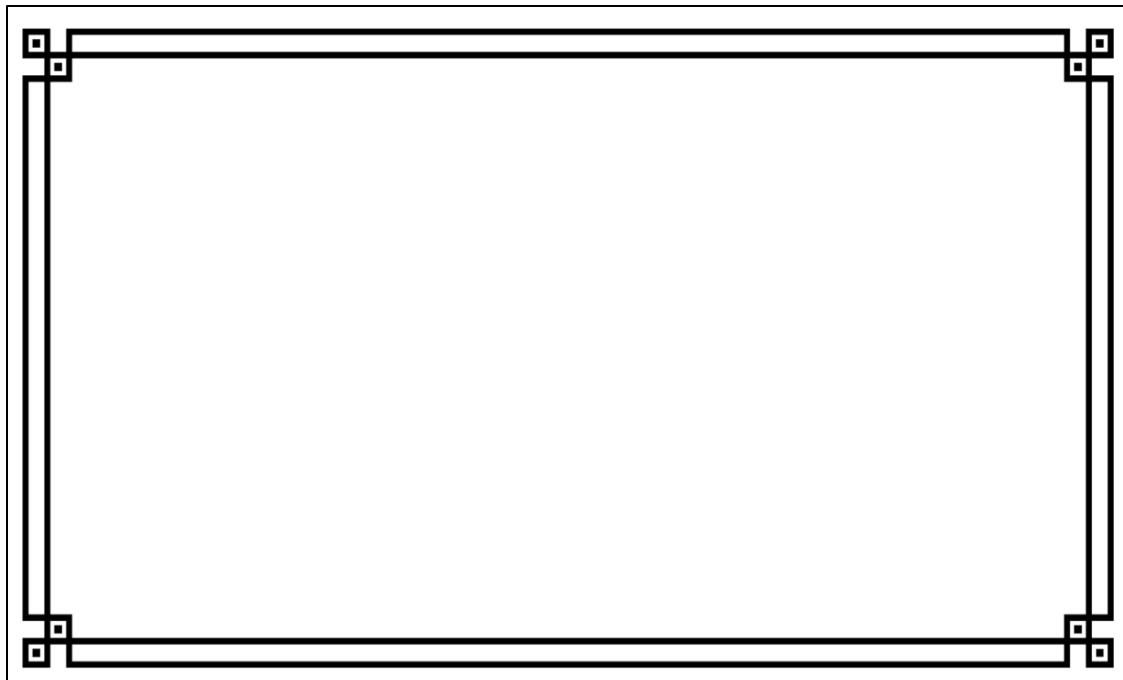
Inside of Card
