Task 1: If you order The Great Canadian and an orange juice, how much will the subtotal (before tax) of your bill be?

Answer: $\$17.99 + \$4.25 = \$22.24$

Task 2: How much would it cost (before tax) for a western omelette with cheese?

$\$16.99 + \$2.50 = \$19.49$

Task 3: How much would the total bill be for a Bacon Temptation oven skillet with an extra egg, French Toast with fresh local maple syrup, and two cups of coffee, including 13% tax?

Answer: $\$18.99 + \$1.50 + \$15.99 + \$2.50 + \$2.75 + \$2.75 = \$44.48$
 $\$44.48 \times .13 \text{ (13\%)} = \5.78
 $\$44.48 + \$5.78 = \$50.26$

Task 4: Which costs more, the B.L.T. or the P.L.T.?

Answer: The P.L.T. (\$16.99 vs. \$14.99)

Task 5: What is the difference in cost (before tax) between a Station Skillet with gluten free toast and one with whole wheat toast?

$(\$18.99 + \$2.50) - \$18.99 = \2.50

Task 6: If you ordered a Mediterranean Omelette and you wanted to add tomatoes, how much would the subtotal be?

$\$18.99 + \$4.00 = \$22.99$

Task 7: You are having breakfast with five of your friends. You each order The Classic and coffee. If you split the bill evenly, including tax, how much would each of you pay?

- $\$11.99 + \$2.75 = \$14.74$
- $\$14.74 \times .13 = \1.92
- $\$14.74 + \$1.92 = \$16.66$
- OR
- $\$11.99 + \$2.75 = \$14.74$
- $\$14.74 \times 6 = \88.44
- $\$88.44 \times .13 = \11.50
- $\$88.44 + \$11.50 = \$99.94$
- $\$99.94 \div 6 = \16.66
