Answer: Multiple. The top five entries for this word on dictionary.com are listed here:

- 1. to put (something) in a position to obstruct an entrance, opening, etc.; shut. Close the door, it's freezing in here.
- 2. to stop or obstruct (a gap, entrance, aperture, etc.). If you close that hole in the foundation, you're less likely to get critters in the basement. Synonyms: choke, clog, bar
- 3. to block or hinder passage across or access to. Because people were littering, the Parks and Recreation department decided to close the woods to picnickers.
- 4. to stop or obstruct the entrances, apertures, or gaps in. He closed the crate to prevent anything falling out and tied it up.
- 5. to make (one's mind) unreceptive or inaccessible to. Don't close your mind to an opinion just because you don't like the person who expressed it.
