Learner Information and Tasks:

- **Task 1:** Go to the Ford Trucks website, www.ford-trucks.com/tsb/fulltext, and locate the Technical Services bulletins Full Text for Ford F-150, model year 2010 Ford trucks.
- **Task 2:** Using bulletin 09-23-7, explain in your own words the issue expressed in this bulletin.
- **Task 3:** Using bulletin 09-23-7, list all of the vehicles this bulletin applies to.
- **Task 4:** Using the technical service bulletins (TSB) main page, select any other model and recall notice and explain in your own words the issue expressed in the bulletin.

Answer Key

Task 1: - Open the internet

- Use a search engine, such as Google, to search "www.ford-trucks.com/tsb/fulltext"

- Use the "Quick Model Selection" to find "2010 F-150" located in the far-left column.
- Click on "2010 F-150"
- Using the technical services bulletin (TSB) main page, locate "09-23-7 (Low Frequency Knocking Noise At Hot Idle"
- Click on "09-23-7" link

Task 2: Answers will vary but should include reference to:

- Vehicles equipped with a 4.6L 3V or 5.4L 3V engine
- Vehicles may exhibit a low frequency knocking noise
- Noise predominately heard from right front wheel are or right hand engine cam cover

- Noise may be generated from the right hand variable camshaft timing
- Task 3: 2009-2010 Ford Expedition, F-150 and 2009-2010 Lincoln Navigator
- **Task 4:** Answers will vary, but should include reference to the vehicle model selection, technical service bulleting number, and bulletin notes
